Read TO your child

You're most likely
already doing this!

Nothing changes as children
grow older.

Keep reading TO them child
even when they can read as
well.

Read everything. - maps,
books, nonfiction, comics, song
lyrics, poetry, etc.

Read WITH your child

This may be a new one!

Big kids that are already reading get stronger by reading aloud.

TRY THIS:

Pick an on-level chapter book (ask your child's teacher where they are) and read every other page WITH them.

Stop when they show they are finished.

Read BY your child

Grab YOUR book and read!

Modeling reading yourself is a great way to encourage more reading at home.

I like to read as my boys are outside playing. I open my book and read a few pages as they ride thier bikes.

Read **BY** your child

At a restaurant? Hand your reader the menu and see what they find.

At a park or hike? Get curious and wonder where something is. Invite your child to find it on the map.

Have a new toy? Open up that instruction manual.
